IN MAPUTO
By Quisine Queen



Maritimo must have one of the best locations in Maputo. Situated on the beach next to Clube Maritimo and opposite the fish market, it is a great place for a sundowner after work, lunch or an early supper.

There are tables on the veranda with umbrellas and a blackboard on entry displaying the daily specials, but the waiters are proactive, and seem to know the ingredients of the dishes and are very attentive.

The menu, which is only in Portuguese, features light meals like sandwiches, tramezzinis, burgers and pregos. The three samoosas are 80mt, as are the delicious rissois having a mixed fish and prawn filling, and have to be the best value I have found so far in Maputo.

Prices are refreshingly reasonable with a Chicken Espatada 270Mt, Prawn and Lulas Espetada 360mt, and Omelettes at 210Mt. Unfortunately the usual wines were available, and it would be so nice if some different ones were available for a change.

An unusual dessert which was recommended to us by our waiter, was a chocolate chilli cake, served with ice cream, which was unfortunately a bit stale, but had a subtle chilli flavour and something I would definitely recommend as being different to the usual desserts found in Maputo restaurants.

Maritimo is located at Av. Marginal, next to the Physical Gym.

ABOUT IMAGINE

IMAGINE Mozambique is a Community Development and Childcare organisation based in KaTembe.

One programme that IMAGINE runs is the Family Homes of Hope, a centre made up of five houses in which full time childcare is provided for orphaned and vulnerable children. Each household is headed by houseparents who live and work there to provide 24/7 care in a family environment. There are currently 45 children at the Family Homes aged between 2 and 19 years.

All households are equipped by IMAGINE to run as stand alone units, but are built together on a site with shared activity centre and playground facilities.

MAPUTO TOURISM OBSERVATORY LAUNCHED TO STRENGTHEN TOURISM DEVELOPMENTS IN THE CAPITAL

The month of June saw the launch of a new initiative to support the evaluation and development of tourism in Mozambique's capital Maputo. The main objectives of the Maputo Tourism Observatory are to champion the monitoring and analysis of the local tourism economy, support the management of tourism operators through market analysis, and, last but not least, promote Maputo as an attractive destination for investment in the tourism sector. Established through the collaboration of 14 public-private organisations engaged in the tourism sector value chain, including the Ministry of Tourism (MITUR), Maputo Municipal Council (CMCM), Mozambican Hotel Association (AHSM), Netherlands Development Organisation (SNV), Institute of Tourism (INATUR), Centre for Investment Promotion (CPI), UNESCO, CEDARTE and the Confederation of Business Associations (CTA), the Observatory is managed by the Mozambican Hotel Association.

A recent study of the tourism value chain carried out by SNV revealed that more than 300,000 tourists visit the Mozambican capital each year, bringing in revenue of about 95 million US dollars and in 2010 generated 4,116 jobs in the areas accommodation, bars & restaurants, transport, arts & crafts and commerce. The tourism sector is particularly important for small and medium businesses which despite their size manage to create employment and thus contribute to poverty reduction. It is interesting also to note that nearly 80% of all visitors to Mozambique in 2010 came from other African countries, 11.9% from Europe, 5.6% from the Americas and 1.5% from Asia.

At the launch ceremony the Minister of Tourism, Fernando Sumbana, stated that this initiative should be rolled out to other parts of the country to get a better understanding of the tourism industry's role in the national economy. CAMPAIGN FOR THE FREE MOVEMENT OF ARTS AND CRAFTS

The area of arts and crafts is intrinsically linked to the tourism industry as a considerable motivation behind visiting another country is the interest in learning something about that country's culture, and, perhaps, take home an artefact as a reminder of a dream holiday. This has in the past occasionally led to unpleasant surprises at the customs desks of Mozambique's border posts when tourists were asked to produce a certificate from the Ministry of Culture for taking home with them a carving or even a simple pestle and mortar. The original motivation of the law was the preservation of Mozambique's cultural heritage and to prevent items of cultural importance from being smuggled out of the country. However, in recent times the Mozambican government has recognized the enormous potential of the arts and crafts sector, as part of the tourism industry, in contributing to the national economy. This was also demonstrated in the tourism value chain study recently carried out in Maputo by the Netherlands Development Organisation (SNV) which showed that the crafts sector there has the potential to bring annual returns of 1.2 million US dollars.

In June a campaign to raise awareness of the correct interpretation of law 10/81 covering the arts and crafts sector was launched by the Mozambican NGO Centre for the Study and Development of the Crafts Sector, CEDARTE, together with the MDG Achievement Fund, UNESCO, ILO, ITC, SNV, Mozambique's Airport Authority, National Institute for Tourism (INATUR) and the ART PAPDEL Project of the Ministry for Territorial Administration.

"The law 10/81 from 25th July, coupled with the ministerial diploma 220-A/2002 from 17th September, authorizes the free circulation of arts and crafts with the country and out of the country without going through customs, provided that items carried by travellers are in reasonable quantities of up to 20kg (non-commercial quantities). The categories of art and crafts mentioned by the law are paintings, sculptures, drawings, prints, batiks, pottery, basketry and tapestries."

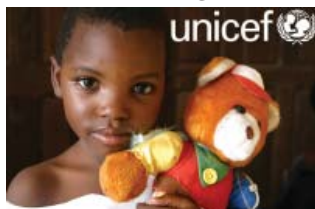
